

Outdoor Adventures



Brunei is known as the Abode of Peace and this is a country that highly protects the pristine condition of its rainforest and marine habitats.

Here are a few ways to go on a nature or adventure trail in Brunei:

ULU TEMBURONG NATIONAL PARK
This is the crown jewel of Brunei's prized green spaces. This sprawling 50,000-hectare expanse of undisturbed primary rainforest stretches over most of southern Temburong.

Considered one of the most diverse ecosystems in the world, the park encompasses a range of habitats, from lowland forests to jungle and mountain forests, that is home to many unique species.

For ecological and practical reasons it is best to visit as a

part of an organized tour. Local travel and tour operators offer packages for trips to the park.

TASEK MERIMBUN HERITAGE PARK

On the list of ASEAN Heritage Parks and Reserves, this park stretches over 2,500 hectares of wetlands. The centerpiece is the freshwater lake, which supports a variety of fish and fauna, with an island in the middle that is connected to the shores with elevated wooden walkways. The surrounding forest is inhabited by species endemic to the region, and is a popular spot for nature lovers.

DIVING

It's a little known fact that Brunei is a diver's paradise with vast coral reefs and colourful marine life in the waters off the sultanate's

coast. Ship wrecks scattered between Brunei and the Malaysian island of Labuan are teeming with sea life. And since Brunei's diving sites don't experience too much traffic, you get to feel like you're in your own underwater world!

BIRD WATCHING

Borneo is home to over 673 species of birds, 53 of them are endemic to Borneo, and the verdant rainforest at the Ulu Temburong National Park is a bird-watcher's paradise. Spot our feathery inhabitants in the trees, or climb to the very top of the famous canopy bridge for the best bird-watching location in the

park. Luagan Lalak, an alluvial dark-water swamp nestled in the Labi Hills Forest Park, is also a prime location for birdwatching enthusiasts.

PROBOSCIS MONKEY TOUR

Get on a boat and cruise down the mangrove-lined waterways. Many species of birds and animals can be spotted on this trip but if you keep your eyes peeled you'll probably find an elusive Proboscis monkey chilling in the mangrove trees.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Ride with a view of Brunei's breathtaking natural landscape by taking a bike tour through jungles and beaches, accompanied by local riders and guides. From long distance cycling to off-road adventure trails, this is a fantastic way to experience Brunei's natural treasures.

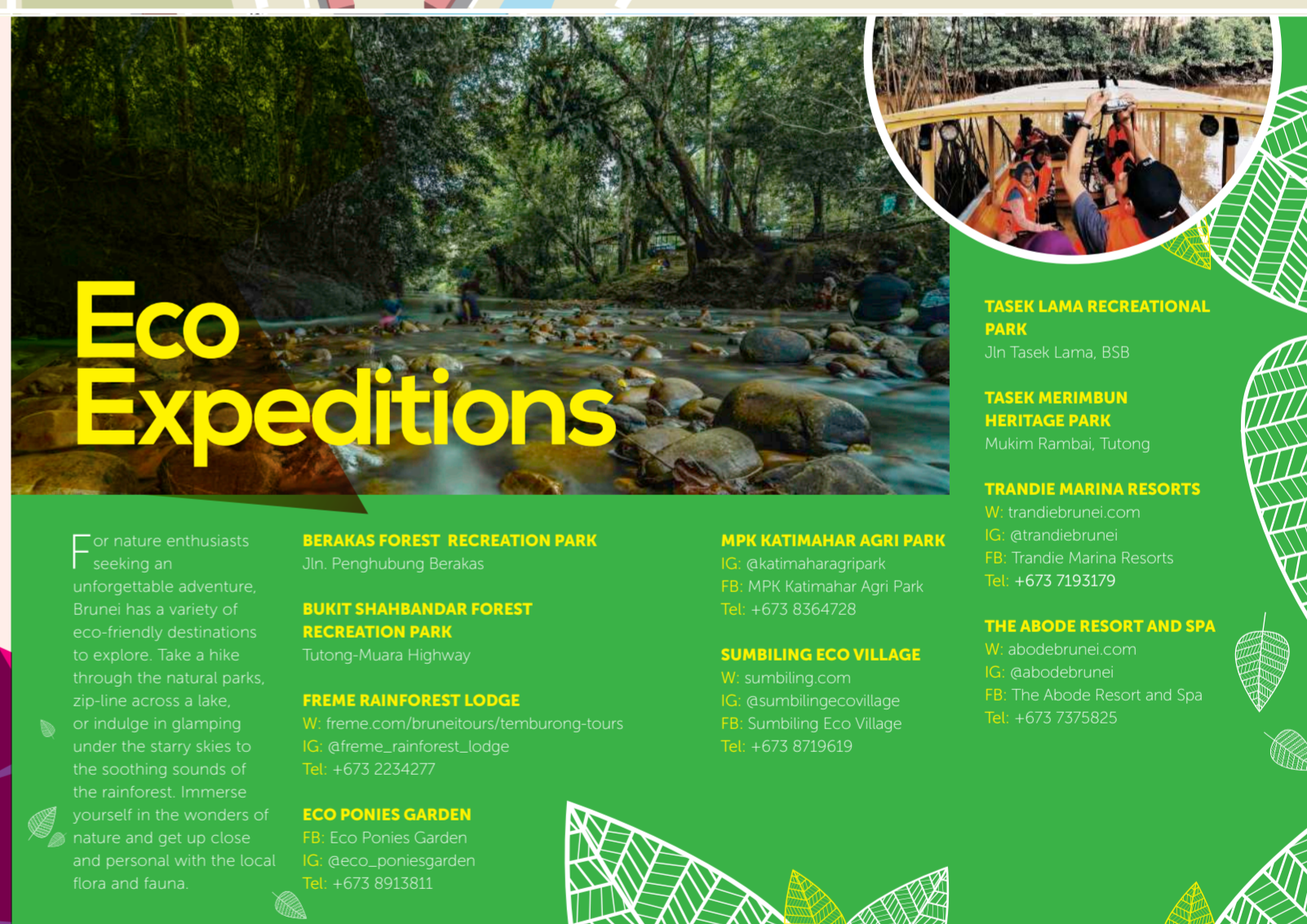

ESSENTIAL INFORMATION

ISLAMIC ETIQUETTE
Despite Islam being the state religion of Brunei Darussalam, the country celebrates its diversity of people and religions. Visitors are welcome to explore the mosques, but it's important to **dress modestly and respectfully**. Women should cover their heads, shoulders, and knees, and some mosques provide robes and shawls to help visitors meet these standards. It's customary to remove shoes before entering, and visitors should avoid passing in front of people who are praying or touching the Al-Quran. Photography is usually permitted, but visitors should ask for permission, especially in mosques. Note that mosques are **typically closed on Fridays during prayer times**.

FRIDAY PRAYERS
To observe the Friday prayer time for Muslims, all banks, businesses, offices, places of interest, retail, food, and beverage outlets in Brunei are **closed between 12:00 noon and 2:00 PM on Fridays**.

BANKS
Banks are usually open from Monday to Thursday at: 7:45 AM to 2:15 PM, 1:30 PM to 5:30 PM, and on Fridays from: 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM, 2:30 PM to 4:00 PM. Some banks have branches with later closing times. Cash withdrawals and deposits can be made from Automated Teller Machines (ATM) that can be found in various shopping complexes and bank branches all over the country. ATM cards affiliated with the international Plus or Citrus systems are accepted at most ATMs.

CREDIT CARDS
Credit cards are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, and major shopping complexes. The most widely accepted cards are VISA and MasterCard. Some establishments accept American Express.

LOST/STOLEN PASSPORTS AND CREDIT CARDS
If you ever do find your passport missing, go to the nearest police station to lodge a police report and inform your embassy to seek further assistance. If your credit cards get lost, make sure you call your bank to cancel the cards immediately.

MONEY CHANGER
This service is available at the airport, banks, hotels and some licensed money changers. To cash or exchange travelers cheques, visit major international banks in the capital.

MONEY REMITTANCE/TRANSFER
Transferring money overseas can be done at all major banks or remittance agencies in Brunei.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS
Mobile prepaid SIM cards are available for purchase at Datastream Digital Sdn Bhd (DSTI), Progresif Sdn Bhd, and Imagine Sdn Bhd service counters as well as the respective authorised vendors' stores.

SMOKING AND VAPING
Smoking and vaping is **prohibited** in both air-conditioned and non-air-conditioned areas in Brunei Darussalam. Smoking is banned in specific places including government buildings, hospitals, recreational and educational centres, public transport, and restaurants. Offenders could be fined.

TOURIST INFORMATION CENTRE
Located at the Kampong Ayer Cultural and Tourism Gallery and at the Brunei International Airport. Visitors can obtain information about Brunei and related pamphlets and maps from here during working hours Mon-Thurs & Saturday (9am to 12:15pm & 1:30pm to 4:30pm).

BUSES
Normal operating hours are from 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM. Bus routes can be found at <https://www.jpd.gov.bn/SitePages/PUBLIC%20BUS%20ROUTE.aspx>. Bus fares start from B\$1.00. Buses heading to other towns in Brunei such as Tutong, Kuala Belait, and Seria depart from the bus terminal located at the multi-storey car park on Jalan Cator in Bandar Seri Begawan.

TAXIS
Metered taxis can be found at the airport, hotels, shopping centres, and the central bus station in Bandar Seri Begawan. Alternatively, grab a Dart Taxi at the tap of a button by downloading the 'Dart' app - a taxi booking application that can be downloaded at the App Store and Google Play.

WATER TAXIS
Unique to Brunei, the water taxi is the most common means of transportation in Kampong Ayer. You can hail a water taxi from the numerous jetties along the banks of Brunei River. The water taxi is an ideal way to view the water village up close. Fares are negotiable but usually a standard ride across the river costs about B\$1.00.

FERRY SERVICES
Passenger ferry services to the Malaysian island of Labuan operate on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM and depart from the Serasa Terminal in Muara Town. The journey takes about 45 minutes to an hour.
